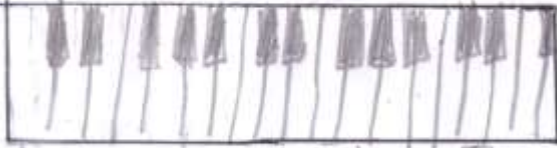

PIANO



There is 88 keys on the piano.
There is 52 white

keys and 36 black keys. The piano was the first instrument to play loud and soft therefore it's called piano-forte its now know as the piano.

- P = piano = soft (quiet)
- PP = pianissimo = very soft
- mp = mezzo piano = moderately soft
- f = forte = loud
- ff = fortissimo = very loud
- mf = mezzo forte = moderately loud

TRIPLETS

When a composer wishes to break up a beat into 3 equal parts in 2, 3 or 4 time, a triplet must be used. A triplet is shown by a figure 3 which may appear on its own or may be written with a slur or a bracket. The following are quaver triplets:

HOLD IT!

- $\frac{1}{2}$ note = 1/2 a count
- Quarter note = 1 count
- Half note = 2 counts
- Quarter note with a dot = 3 counts
- Whole note = 4 counts



There you just saw what each note equals! They tell you how long to hold the note. They are used in every piece of music. We also use them to add up how many counts in a bar.
